

The School uniform reflects the distinctiveness of the School within the community and distinguishes our students from all other schools.

While a student is wearing the School uniform, they are representing the School, whether it be on excursion, public transport, in shopping centres or elsewhere. It is expected that all students will wear the uniform correctly at all times and behave in a way that is honouring to God and the School.

Uniform items are available from Hannah's, the School Uniform shop.

The Uniform Code will assist parents and students to ensure that our high standards of dress are maintained.

The Uniform Code

The Summer Uniform is to be worn in Terms 1 and 4. The Winter Uniform is to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

The Uniform should be well maintained. Damaged or defaced items should be replaced promptly. All items of clothing and footwear must be clearly labelled with the student's name.

Bag

Bottle green school bag with the School logo. The school bag is compulsory for all students.

Blazer

The wearing of the School Blazer is optional except for Senior School where a blazer is a compulsory outer garment for all formal occasions and when travelling to School in Terms 3 and 4. No jacket or coat other than the School Blazer may be worn.

Camps

Clothes should be in good clean condition, modest and suitable for general wear at camp. Appropriate footwear is required to be worn for all activities. Girls may not wear tops which expose their midriff, are sleeveless or are overly revealing. Students may not wear low hipsters. Slogans or symbols on clothes, especially t-shirts must not be inappropriate. Hair and jewellery should be worn as per the uniform code. The school reserves the right to withdraw students from activities if they deem the clothes worn are unsuitable.

Footwear

Plain black hard leather lace-up shoes, able to be polished, are the only footwear that may be worn with the summer and winter uniforms. No buckles, heels or platforms, suede, sneakers, boots, crepe soles or stitched tops are to be worn. It is compulsory for students to wear shoes that meet safety regulations for Science, Art and Technology classes.

The only acceptable shoe style for Middle and Senior students is pictured.



Junior School students may wear black leather buckle up or velcro fastened shoes.

Sports shoes must be sturdy and predominantly white. To be worn with the sports uniform only.

Gloves and Scarves

Girls and boys black or green winter gloves and scarves.

Hairstyles

Acceptable standards of hairstyle are required for all students. Hair that is cut in a radical or extreme hairstyle is not acceptable.

Girls - Shoulder length hair or longer is to be tied back in plaits, pigtails or pony tail. All hair accessories are to be bottle green or white. Scrunchies in uniform fabric may be worn.

Boys - Shaved head is not acceptable. Hair should not be worn below the top of the shirt collar, unless approved specifically by the relevant Head of School. Hair must always be clean, neat and tidy, well brushed and combed. Boys' hair may be clipped to a minimum length of 6mm (no.2 clipper setting). Boys must be clean shaven.

Anyone in doubt about hairstyle should consult their Head of School. Students are not permitted to change the natural colour of their hair. However, students may highlight their natural hair colour.

Hats

The wearing of the school hat with logo is **compulsory** for all students for all outdoor activities including before and after school, recess and lunch. No other hat may be worn with the School Uniform.

Jewellery

Other than a watch, the only accessories that may be worn to school are by girls only. Middle and Senior girls may wear one small ring, a necklace consisting of a fine chain with a small cross and/or one matching pair of small plain studs or small sleepers in the lobe of the ears. Junior School girls may wear one matching pair of small plain studs or small sleepers in the lobe of the ears. No clear studs are permitted. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings or jewellery of any description. No other piercings are permitted.

Makeup

In Junior and Middle School the wearing of makeup is unacceptable in every form, except under medical advice. Students wearing makeup to school will be asked to remove it immediately. Senior School students may wear a little makeup consistent with their natural colouring. The wearing of eye shadow, coloured lipstick and/or coloured nail polish are not acceptable.

Paint Smock and Tech Apron

Clothing protection must be worn in all Visual Arts and Design and Technology classes.

Raincoats

Junior School students are to wear a yellow raincoat. Years 5 to 12 male students are to wear a grey raincoat and Years 5 to 12 female students are to wear a dark green raincoat.

Sports Bag

Bottle green sports bag for carrying sports gear only.

Sports Carnivals

Students are to wear either full school PE uniform or full school uniform for Sports Carnivals. Students may bring a t-shirt in the appropriate house colour to wear at the sporting venue.

Swimwear

When representing the School, the official school swimwear is to be worn - black costume with the School logo.

Undershirts

Should be white or neutral in colour and not display any images.

Ties

Students in Years 11 and 12 wear their tie throughout the year. Students in K – Year 10 wear the school tie during Terms 2 and 3 with the winter uniform, and at special events throughout the year.

Junior School Prep

Summer

- Shorts: Junior School bottle green with white piping, knit fabric
T-Shirt: Prep T-Shirt

Winter

- Tracksuit: Green/white microfibre pants and jacket with logo
T-Shirt: Long sleeved Prep T-Shirt

All Year

- Hats: Bottle green, wide brimmed, with logo
Socks: White ankle
Shoes: Predominantly white sports shoes
Accessories: Hair gear in bottle green or white, green scarf & gloves
Back Pack: Small bottle green, with logo
Library Bag: Bottle green, with logo
Paint smock: Bottle green

All items (except special Prep T-Shirts) are uniform for Junior School and are able to be worn in Kindergarten.

Junior School Kindergarten to Year 4

Girls - Summer

- Dress: Green/white pinstriped fabric, green piping and green buttons. Dress length to the knee
- Socks: Bottle green, ankle

Girls - Winter

- Tunic: Bottle green, with belt. Dress length to the knee
- Blouse: White long sleeve with Peter-Pan collar
- Socks: Knee high bottle green or bottle green tights

Boys - Summer

- Shirt: Short sleeve white, one pocket, with logo and green trim. Worn out over shorts
- Shorts: Grey gaberdine, half-elastic back or side tab
- Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

Boys - Winter

- Shirt: Long sleeve white, one pocket. Worn tucked in
- Trousers: Long leg grey melange school trousers
- Tie: Bottle green with Junior School design
- Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

All Year

- Formal Shoes: Plain black hard leather lace-up, velcro or buckle
- Jumper: V-neck bottle green, wool blend or cotton blend. No hand knits
- Vest: Bottle green, wool blend. No hand knits
- Blazer: Optional – bottle green with logo
- Paint Smock: Bottle green
- Hats: Bottle green, wide-brimmed, with logo
- Accessories: Bottle green or black scarf and/or gloves

Sports

- Polo Shirt: Green/white polo with school logo
- Shorts: Green with white piping, knit fabric
- Tracksuit: Green/white microfibre pants and jacket with school logo
- Socks: School ankle sports sock
- Sport Shoes: Predominantly white sport shoe

Girls - Summer

Dress: Green/white check dress. Dress length to the knee
Socks: White ankle socks

Girls - Winter

Skirt: Bottle green check fabric. Dress length to the knee
Blouse: White $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve fitted blouse
Pantyhose: Black opaque, 70 Denier

Boys - Summer

Shirt: Short sleeve white, one pocket, with logo and green striped pocket. Worn out over shorts
Shorts: Grey gaberdine, half-elastic back or side tab
Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

Boys - Winter

Shirt: Short sleeve white, with logo and green striped pocket. Worn tucked in with tie (Optional – plain white long sleeve shirt with one pocket)
Trousers: Long leg grey melange school trousers
Tie: Bottle green with Middle School design
Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

All Year

Formal Shoes: Plain black hard leather lace-up shoes, able to be polished. No buckles, heels or platforms, suede, sneakers, boots, crepe soles or stitched tops are to be worn.
Jumper: V-neck bottle green, wool blend. No hand knits
Vest: Bottle green, wool blend. No hand knits
Blazer: Optional – bottle green with logo
Hats: Bottle green, wide-brimmed, with logo
Accessories: Bottle green or black scarf and/or gloves
Belts: (optional) Black leather with silver buckle

Sports

Polo Shirt: Green/white polo with school logo
Sport Jersey: White with green stripes
Shorts: Bottle green with white piping, knit fabric
Tracksuit: Green/white microfibre pants and jacket with logo
Socks: School ankle sports sock (anklet not permitted)
Sport Shoes: Predominantly white sport shoes

Senior School Years 9 - 12

Girls - Summer

Dress: Green/white striped dress. Dress length to the knee
Socks: White ankle socks

Girls - Winter

Skirt: Tartan kilt/skirt. Dress length to the knee
Blouse: White $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve fitted blouse
Pantyhose: Black opaque, 70 Denier

Boys - Summer

Shirt: Short sleeve white, with logo and 'Senior' design pocket. Worn out over trousers or shorts
Trousers: Long leg grey melange school trousers, not jeans or cords
Shorts: Optional. Grey gaberdine with side tab
Tie: Years 11 & 12 students. Bottle green with white diagonal stripes
Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

Boys - Winter

Shirt: Long sleeve white shirt or short sleeve white shirt with logo. Worn tucked in with tie
Trousers: Long leg grey melange school trousers
Tie: Bottle green with white diagonal stripes
Socks: Grey ankle with green stripes

All Year

Formal Shoes: Plain black hard leather lace-up, able to be polished. No buckles, heels or platforms, suede, sneakers, boots, crepe soles or stitched tops are to be worn
Jumper: V-neck bottle green, wool blend. No hand knits
Vest: Bottle green, wool blend. No hand knits
Blazer: **Compulsory** outer garment for formal occasions. Must be worn travelling to School during Terms 2 and 3
Hats: Bottle green wide-brimmed or cap with logo. Compulsory for all outdoor activities
Accessories: Bottle green or black scarf and/or gloves
Belts: Black leather with silver buckle

Polo Shirt: Green/white polo with school logo
Sport Jersey: White with green stripes
Shorts: Green with white piping, knit fabric
Tracksuit: Green/white microfibre pants and jacket with logo
Socks: School ankle sports sock (anklet not permitted)
Sport Shoes: Predominantly white sport shoe
